Combined Tests: Tadpole, Green as Grass, Maiden, Beginner Novice, Novice, and Training

AWARDS: ▶ Division Ribbons 1st - 5th

▶ Dressage High Point Award: (each show) **Leather Halter** by CENTRIC FARM LLC.

▶ *Series* Year End Championship Awards—Eligible **if** you have entered 2 or more shows throughout series.

▶ *Series* Year End Award for Dressage High Score – Sponsored by **CENTRIC FARM LLC**

▶ NCDCTA points in D & CT classes; Members include #s for Horse, Rider & Owner on Entry Form.

COGGINS: Have current negative Coggins with you in your vehicle on show day and send Coggins copy with Entry.
(Current copies will be kept on file for the calendar year)

FEES: Complete Entry & Release Form and send checks to Steeple Hill Farm. Must be received by Closing Date.

- **DRESSAGE Test**...your choice: \$30 per test
- **Western DRESSAGE Test:** \$30 per test
- **COMBINED Tests:** \$50 per test

Other FEES: For horses at show NOT competing, MARK “Non-Compete” on Entry Form, submit with Coggins, check,

- Additional Stadium Jumping Rounds (un-judged) \$20/ea and signed SHF Release Form.
- Mini CROSS COUNTRY Schooling: \$20
- GUEST Horse: \$20

FACILITY: Dressage Ring: Tests are held in 20 x 40m or 20 x 60m (as appropriate).

- ▶ **Warm-up areas:** are separate for Dressage and Stadium Jumping.
- ▶ **Parking:** designated areas are easy pull-thru and turn around for competitors and ample parking for spectators.
- ▶ **Overnight:** stalls (limited) and camping available (reservations required): mark on Entry Form.

RIDE TIMES: will be posted on our SHF Website/Facebook by 11:45 pm, **Thursday**, before each show and emailed to you as a PDF document with Ride Times. If you do not have access to Website, Facebook or email . . . please TEXT 336 - 210 - 9555. Check your email, Friday morning for your Ride Times. After Closing Date, Entries *may* be allowed: \$20 Late FEE per ENTRY.

REFUNDS: If Show Management cancels a show, weather* or otherwise, Entries will be refunded.

If a Competitor Scratches AFTER Closing Dates - unless show is cancelled - No Refund

If a Competitor Scratches BEFORE *midnight prior to the* **Wednesday** Closing Date, his/her Entry Fees will be **applied to future shows** (less a \$15 office fee).

***WEATHER Cancellations:** by noon FRIDAY prior to show. Please check: Instagram/SHF Facebook page for cancellations.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- Ride Times: available on Steeple Hill Farm website, Facebook page, Thursday, by midnight, prior to Saturday show.
- For “ADDS”: Upon check-in, an open signed Check must be left with the Show Secretary.
- Current Rules: competition will be held in accordance with the current rules of **USDF, USEA, USEF, and WDAA.**
- Tack and Bits: restricted to **USDF, USEA, USEF, and WDAA Rules.** (No exceptions)
- Medical ARMBANDS: are required and ASTM approved helmets when mounted.
- Ribbons and Awards: 1st through 5th place in each Class. Year End Awards in each Division.

Fees:

- Combined Test: \$50 Dressage or Western Dressage Test: \$30
- Additional Jumper Rounds: \$20 each (un-judged)**
- Mini Cross Country Schooling: \$20
- Leadline Fun Class: \$10 (during Lunch break)
- Guest Horse on grounds: \$20
- Stabling: \$25 one night, \$30 two nights (Limited stalls)
- Shavings: \$8 per bag
- Pasture Board: \$15 one night, \$20 two nights (Limited paddocks)
- Muck Deposit: \$40 (Separate Check)
- Competitor Entry Cancellation: (after Closing Date) No Refund
- Scratch Fee: scratches received (prior to Closing Date) Entry will be **applied to future shows** (less a \$15 office fee)
- Change Fee: \$10
- RV Hookup: \$35 per night (one space)
- Camp Site: \$15 per night

Late Fee: Entries received AFTER the **Wednesday** Closing Date will be subject to a \$20 Late Fee.

Due to the inconsistency of the USPS, Entries must be received by the Show Secretary on or before Closing Date. Entries must be accompanied with payment to be processed. Entries received without payment will not be handled.
